SMARTLEAF®

Smartleaf® compost is also called College Park's Black Gold by those who have used it. It is rich in nutrients, so it will keep your flowers and grass happy!



Smartleaf® is produced from locally collected municipal leaves which are piled into long rows called windrows for composting. Grass clippings are added for a supply of nitrogen to the microorganisms which decompose the leaves. The windrow piles are about six feet high by sixteen feet wide. A windrow turner drives over the piles and turns the leaves, incorporating oxygen which allows the windrows to decompose more evenly.

Heat is generated in the windrows by microorganisms as they transform the leaves into compost. The temperature is monitored for quality assurance and is maintained at 55° C or higher which kills any present weed seeds and harmful plant pathogens.

The compost is screened to filter out large particles of debris. Smartleaf® is a screened product that has particle sizes under ½ inch which is top grade dressing. The composition is routinely tested, and has a pH between 7.4-8.0

USES

- As a soil amendment to incorporate organic matter into existing soils.
- Used in ornamental planting beds and vegetable gardens. Since it has and holds nutrients, it acts as a slow release organic fertilizer.
- Tilled into existing soil before turf establishment.
- As a topdressing in turf renovation projects.
- As a component in potting mixture for nursery and greenhouse crop production.

DELIVERIES

Delivery is available for an additional fee, and only by appointment. Deliveries are scheduled on Thursdays and Fridays. The driveway area for delivery must be a minimum of 10 feet wide and be free of overhead wires and branches. During peak delivery season, there may be a wait for an available delivery date. Deliveries are made in driveways; they cannot be made on the yard or in the street or right of way.

YARD PICKUPS

Material may be picked up from our facility Monday-Friday from 8:00 am-11:30 am and 1:00pm-3:30 pm. We can load material into an open bodied truck; otherwise you should bring containers and a shovel. You must stop at the main office when you arrive to pay for the material *before* you pick it up or enter the compost yard.
