

MTPD Overview

- Jurisdiction and arrest powers throughout 1,500-square mile transit zone
- Three Bureaus
 - Administrative Services
 - Patrol Operations
 - Homeland Security Investigations and Intelligence
- Two Offices
 - Office of Emergency Management
 - Office of Professional Responsibility and Inspections
- Authorized Strength 746
 - 490 Sworn
 - 165 Special Police
 - 91 Civilian

MTPD Resources and Capabilities

- Anti-Terrorism Team
- Canine Unit (EOD/Patrol)
- Explosive Ordinance Disposal
- Local Joint Terrorism Task Force
- Special Response Team
- Office of Emergency Management



Crime

- Developed MetroStat – similar to COMPSTAT
- Part 1 crime is at a five-year low
 - Probability of being crime victim on Metrorail system for CY2014 (Jan – June) was 4.29 per million riders
 - Reduced 29% from 2013
- Crimes against person
 - Aggravated assaults
 - Assaults on employees
 - Robbery
- Crimes against property
 - Vehicle related crimes
 - Theft of bicycles
 - Larceny snatch and pickpocket





Strategies to Improve Security

- Effective organizational safety and security culture
- Employee training
- Mass communication to employees variety of channels
- Public awareness and outreach
- Emergency preparedness
- Dynamic kiosk screens
- Local and regional drills with key stakeholders



Information Sharing

- Partnership with over 40 law enforcement entities
- Key to success is information sharing with local law enforcement entities and Federal partners
 - Department of Homeland Security (DHS)
 - Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI)
 - Federal Transportation Administration (FTA)
 - Department of Defense (DOD)
 - Transportation Security Administration (TSA)
