Following the Public Hearing, the Mayor and Council approved the implementation of Permit Restricted Parking in the 4700 block of Tecumseh Street from Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m., and Saturday/Sunday, from 12:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.
