

MINUTES
Special Session of the College Park City Council
Tuesday, June 5, 2007
8:13 P.M.

During the regularly scheduled Worksession of the College Park City Council on June 5, 2007, a motion was made by Councilmember Perry and seconded by Councilmember Fellows to enter Special Session. The motion passed 8-0-0.

07-G-68 To Authorize The City Manager To Sign An Agreement for Legal Representation

A motion was made by Councilmember Catlin and seconded by Councilmember Perry to authorize the City Manager to sign an agreement for legal representation with Suellen M. Ferguson of the law firm of Council, Baradel, Kosmerl and Nolan, P.A., in Annapolis, Maryland.

Councilmember Catlin commented that on May 31, the partnership of Levan, Ferguson & Levan, P.A. dissolved, with Bob Levan, Elissa Levan and Karen Ruff joining the firm of Funk & Bolton. Suellen Ferguson joined the firm of Council, Baradel, and had been selected to become the City's new legal counsel. Councilmember Catlin said the City had been well served by Levan, Ferguson & Levan, and expressed confidence that the City would continue to be well represented by Ms. Ferguson.

There were no comments from the audience on this item.

Mayor Brayman praised Bob Levan and the firm of Levan, Ferguson & Levan, for the legal representation they provided the City.

The motion passed 8-0-0.
