A motion was made by Councilmember Wojahn and seconded by Councilmember Stullich to authorize the City Manager to complete and sign the 2009 Maryland Municipal League Legislative Action Request form to support a task force to study the issue of overcrowding.

There were no comments from the audience on this item.

Mayor Brayman said the issue of overcrowding goes beyond student housing.

The motion carried 8-0-0.
