

**MINUTES**  
**Special Session of the College Park City Council**  
**Tuesday, May 6, 2008**  
**9:30 p.m.**

**PRESENT:** Mayor Brayman; Councilmembers Molinatto, Wojahn, Catlin, Perry, Stulich, Mark Cook, Hampton and Mary Cook; Student Liaison Danielle Kogut.

**ABSENT:** None.

During the regularly scheduled Worksession of the College Park City Council, a motion to enter a Special Session was made by Councilmember Perry and seconded by Councilmember Molinatto. Mayor Brayman stated the Special Session is needed to vote on an Emergency Ordinance to correct a drafting error in the fence ordinance. The motion carried 6-0-0 (Councilmembers Wojahn and Mark Cook were out of the Chamber for this vote) and the Council entered Special Session at 9:30 p.m.

**Action Items:**

**08-O-03      Emergency Ordinance Of The Mayor And Council Of The City Of College Park Amending Chapter 87, "Building," By Repealing And Reenacting Section 87-23 "Fences" To Clarify The Definition Of Fence By Deleting Unintended Language To Correct A Drafting Error.**

A motion was made by Councilmember Perry and seconded by Councilmember Mary Cook to adopt Ordinance 08-O-03, and Emergency Ordinance Of The Mayor And Council Of The City Of College Park Amending Chapter 87, "Building," By Repealing And Reenacting Section 87-23 "Fences" To Clarify The Definition Of Fence By Deleting Unintended Language To Correct A Drafting Error.

Councilmember Perry stated a drafting error was made in the definition of "fence" during an extensive renovation to the fence ordinance in 2007; unintended language was left in the ordinance by mistake. This is a technical amendment and does not change the substance of what was intended for adoption.

There were no comments from the audience on this motion.

There were no comments from the Council.

The motion passed 8-0-0.
