

Minutes
Special Session of the College Park City Council
February 17, 2009
11:08 p.m.

Present: Mayor Brayman; Councilmembers Molinatto, Wojahn, Catlin, Stullich, Mark Cook, Hampton, Mary Cook; Student Liaison Dan Hartinger.

During a regularly scheduled Worksession of the College Park City Council, a motion was made by Councilmember Mark Cook and seconded by Councilmember Wojahn to enter into a Special Session. Mayor Brayman noted the Special Session was needed to act on a state legislative matter that requires immediate attention. The possibility of the Special Session was advertised on the Worksession agenda. The motion passed 7-0-0, and the Council entered Special Session at 11:08 p.m.

09-G-11 Approve a Letter In Support Of HB 27 – Transportation – Intercounty Connector – Elimination of Funding

A motion was made by Councilmember Wojahn and seconded by Councilmember Molinatto that the City Council authorize the Mayor to sign a letter in support of HB 27, entitled, “Transportation – Intercounty Connector – Elimination of Funding.”

Councilmember Wojahn stated that the City is on record opposing the Intercounty Connector, and took the same position last year on a bill to eliminate funding for the ICC.

Student Liaison Hartinger spoke in support of the motion.

There were no comments from the audience.

The motion carried 7-0-0.

A motion was made by Councilmember Stullich and seconded by Councilmember Wojahn to adjourn the Special Session. The motion carried 7-0-0, and Mayor Brayman adjourned the Special Session at 11:12 p.m.
