Parker, Jr. of the Prince George's County Planning Board to request funding from the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission FY 2011 budget for a new entrance gateway to Hollywood Community Park, conduct a study of lighting along the Paint Branch Trail, a new display board at the entrance to the Cherry Hill Neighborhood Park, purchase and install closed circuit television cameras and license plate readers along the Trolley Trail and support for the College Park Dog Park Association expanding the dog park located in Acredale Park.
