Special Session of the College Park City Council
Wednesday, September 16, 2009
9:56 p.m.

PRESENT: Mayor Brayman; Councilmembers Molinatto, Wojahn, Catlin, Perry, Mark Cook, and Hampton; Deputy Student Liaison Becca Lurie.

ABSENT: Councilmembers Stulich and Mary Cook.

During the regularly scheduled Worksession of the College Park City Council, a motion to enter a Special Session was made by Councilmember Perry and seconded by Councilmember Catlin.

09-G-72 Motion to approve a letter Chairman Jackson to deny the transfer of a Class B+, Beer, Wine and Liquor License to Varsity Grille of College Park, LLC, t/a Varsity Grille, 8424 Baltimore Avenue from Lasick's Liquors, Inc., t/a Lasick's College Inn, 9128 Baltimore Avenue, and of Amendments To Varsity Grille Property Use Agreement.

A motion was made by Councilmember Wojahn and seconded by Councilmember Catlin to approve a letter to Chairman Jackson to deny the transfer of a Class B+ Beer, Wine and Liquor License. If the City does not received written confirmation of the continuance of the hearing, Councilman Catlin will attend the hearing on the City's behalf and present the letter. This letter is only to be given to the Prince George's County Board of Liquor License if the hearing scheduled for September 22, 2009 is not issued a continuance.

Suellen Ferguson stated that we should receive a written notice from the Prince George's County Board of License Commissions regarding the continuance of the hearing.

There were no comments from the audience.

The motion carried 6-0-0.

Mayor Brayman declared the Special Session in recess at 9:00 p.m.

A motion to recess the Special Session was made by Councilmember Mark Cook and seconded by Councilmember Wojahn. The motion carried 5-0-0, and the Special Session was recessed at 10:27 p.m. Councilmember Perry absent.
