Ordinance 09-O-07

An Ordinance Of The Mayor And Council Of The City Of College Park, Maryland, Amending Chapter 184 “Vehicles And Traffic”, Article III “Parking Meters” By Repealing And Reenacting §184-17, “Definitions” , §184-18, “Operation”, §184-19, “Violations” §184-20, “Enforcement; Violations And Penalties” To Specifically Incorporate The Multi-Space Meter/ Pay Station System

Mayor Brayman opened the Public Hearing on Ordinance 09-O-07 at 7:39 p.m. and invited Mr. Ryan to provide an overview. Mr. Ryan stated that the City has recently installed multi-space pay station systems in the City Hall parking lot and the new downtown parking garage, and has removed the individual parking meters from those lots. These pay stations stations allow you to pay to park for an unlimited amount of time in the garage. With implementation of the new pay station system, the wording in the City Code needed to be brought up to date, to add the multi-space pay station system, and to add that a patron can now pay by means other than “coin,” as the new system takes currency and credit cards.

There was no public comment on this Ordinance.

Mayor Brayman stated that there would be no further public comment on this ordinance unless there is a substantial change, and declared the Public Hearing closed at 7:45 p.m.
