

**MINUTES**  
**Public Hearing of the College Park City Council**  
**Petition Request For The Installation Of Traffic Calming Devices In The**  
**9400 Block Of 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Between Indian Lane And Fox Street)**

**Tuesday, August 10, 2010**  
**7:20 p.m.**

Mayor Fellows called the Public Hearing to order at 7:20 p.m. and stated this public hearing is on the petition request to install traffic calming devices in the 9400 block of 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue (between Indian Lane and Fox Street)

Steve Halpern gave an introduction. Traffic counters were placed on this block from May 6 to May 13. An analysis was performed using data collected on May 12 and May 13 which represented the worst traffic. The data found that the warrants for traffic volume and for speed were not met. Based on the information collected, staff does not recommend installation of speed humps at this time.

**Comments from the audience:**

**Jackie Kelley, 9406 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue:** Ms. Kelly stated she was the spokesperson for all the homes on the street. In March there was a very serious hit and run accident by a car travelling north on 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue. She recounted all the damage done by the driver. Although not a normal occurrence, it caused the neighbors on the block to sign the petition requesting traffic calming. All six families on the block have made the request. She has trouble backing out of her driveway because people don't stop at the nearby four-way stop sign. There is a lot of through traffic by drivers going to the Post Office. Ms. Kelly stated the traffic and speeding has gotten worse in the last few years.

There being no further comment, Mayor Fellows closed the Public Hearing at 7:26 p.m.
