

**Minutes
Special Session of the College Park City Council

A motion was made by Councilmember Afzali and seconded by Councilmember Wojahn that the City approve a letter in support of SB 334, the crossfile of HB 348 that the Council previously voted to support, and to authorize the Mayor to testify that the Council would support an amendment similar to the one passed in the House that reduced the radius from three miles to one mile.
