Charter Resolution 10-CR-01
A Charter Resolution Of The Mayor And Council Of The City Of College Park, Maryland,
Amending Article VII “Powers And Duties Of Mayor And Council,”
§C76, “Condemnation,” To Eliminate A Reference To A State Code Provision
That No Longer Applies.

PRESENT: Mayor Fellows; Councilmembers Catlin, Perry, Afzali and Mitchell.

ABSENT: Councilmembers Nagle, Wojahn, Stullich and Cook.

Mayor Fellows called the Public Hearing to order at 7:17 p.m.

Ms. Ferguson provided an overview. The purpose of the Charter Amendment Resolution is to delete an unnecessary clause in the City’s Charter which refers to a section of a state code that no longer exists. The current section in the state code that applies to condemnation by municipalities applies whether we reference it or not.

Councilmember Perry described this as a “housekeeping” item.

There was no one to testify on this item.

Mayor Fellows declared the public hearing adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
