

**MINUTES**  
**Special Session of the College Park City Council**

During a regularly scheduled Worksession of the College Park City Council, a motion was made by Councilmember Wojahn and seconded by Councilmember Stullich to enter into a Special Session in order to remand a variance request to the City's Advisory Planning Commission. The Special Session was requested so as not to unnecessarily delay the applicant's request. The motion passed 7 -1 - 0 (Perry opposed) and the Special Session convened at 11:08 p.m.

**11-G-75 Remand to APC: CPV-2011-01, 9511 49<sup>th</sup> Place, College Park**

**A motion was made by Councilmember Nagle and seconded by Councilmember Wojahn to remand the recommendation of the Advisory Planning Commission regarding Variance Application CPV-2011-01, regarding 9511 49<sup>th</sup> Place, College Park, Maryland, to the Advisory Planning Commission for further proceedings, to include reopening the record to include testimony from persons who did not receive the required statutory notice, and to make such additional recommendations as they deem appropriate, if any, based on the additional evidence.**

There were no comments from the audience or from the Council.

**The motion passed 7 – 1 – 0 (Perry opposed).**
