**Ordinance 11-O-13**  
**An Ordinance Of The Mayor And Council Of The City Of College Park, Maryland,**  
**Amending Chapter 141, “Nuisances”, §141-7, “Signs Or Advertisements” To Clarify That**  
**The Law Is Applicable In All City Rights Of Way, And To Include Enforcement Of Sign**  
**Posting Restrictions In State Rights Of Way And To Set A Fine**

Mayor Pro Tem Catlin opened the Public Hearing on Ordinance 11-O-13 at 7:32 p.m. and invited Suellen Ferguson to give an overview.

Ms. Ferguson stated that this Ordinance clarifies Section 141-7 of the City Code that the restrictions to the placement of signs in the right of way applies to all City rights of way. It also allows the City to take advantage of authority given by the state legislature to also remove signs from State Highway Administration rights of way and to set a fine consistent with the state law.
