**Charter Resolution Of The Mayor And Council Of The City Of College Park, Maryland,**  
**Amending Article III “Mayor And Council”, §C3-6, “Vacancies” And Article IV, “Voting**  
**And Elections” §C4-5, “Petitions For Candidacy” To Adopt A Process To Fill The Offices**  
**Of Mayor And Council In The Event There Is No Qualified Candidate**

**PRESENT:** Mayor Pro Tem Catlin; Councilmembers Nagle, Mitchell, Cook, and Wojahn.

Mayor Pro Tem Catlin opened the Public Hearing on Charter Amendment 11-CR-02 at 7:45 p.m. and invited Suellen Ferguson to give an overview.

Ms. Ferguson stated that the City Charter does not currently address the situation when no one qualifies to run for Mayor or for Council. This proposal would amend sections C3-6 and C4-5 of the Charter to give Council the authority, but not the requirement, to appoint someone should that situation arise.
