

**MINUTES**  
**Special Session of the College Park City Council**  
**Council Chambers**

During a regularly scheduled Worksession of the College Park City Council, a motion was made by Councilmember Afzali and seconded by Councilmember Kabir to enter into a Special Session to consider sending a letter to the County Council with the City's request for the FY 2013 M-NCPPC budget that requires action by Council before the next regular meeting. The possibility of the Special Session was advertised on the Worksession agenda. The motion passed 8 – 0 – 0 and the Special Session commenced at 7:55 p.m.

**12-G-53 Approval of a Letter to the County Council with requests for the Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission FY 2013 Budget**

**A motion was made by Councilmember Wojahn and seconded by Councilmember Kabir to approve a letter to the Prince George's County Council expressing our priorities for the FY 2013 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission budget.**

Councilmember Wojahn stated that the letter would include the following projects:

Items already included in the proposed FY 2013 M-NCPPC Budget

An amendment to the College Park-Riverdale Transit District Development Plan (TDDP)

A study of a potential community center in the Hollywood Commercial District

M-NCPPC has allocated funding for the amendment to the College Park-Riverdale TDDP in the proposed FY 2013 budget and has programmed money for a feasibility study for the North College Park Community Center for FY 2016.

The following projects which are not yet included in the proposed M-NCPPC budget:

A Cherry Hill neighborhood park display board

A new stormwater inlet at Hollywood Community Park

A New Entrance Gateway to Hollywood Community Park

A study of lighting along the Paint Branch Trail  
Support for the College Park Dog Park Association park expansion

There were no comments from the audience.
