

MINUTES
Special Session of the College Park City Council
Council Chambers
Tuesday, June 5, 2012
8:12 – 8:16 p.m.

During a regularly scheduled Worksession of the College Park City Council, a motion was made by Councilmember Afzali and seconded by Councilmember Mitchell to enter into a Special Session to approve a letter to the governor regarding funding for the state's Youth Service Bureaus. This item had been brought to the Council's attention just the day before. The motion carried 6 – 0 – 0 and the Council entered into the Special Session at 8:12 p.m.

A motion was made by Councilmember Afzali and seconded by Councilmember Mitchell to approve a letter to Gov. O'Malley urging no cut in funding to the state's Youth Service Bureaus.

Councilmember Mitchell suggested asking the 21st Delegation to also send a support letter.

Councilmember Stullich suggested edits to the letter.

The motion was approved 6 – 0 – 0.

Staff was authorized to sign the letter on the Mayor's behalf.

Adjourn: A motion was made by Councilmember Stullich and seconded by Councilmember Day to adjourn from the Special Session. The motion carried 6 – 0 – 0 and Mayor Fellows adjourned the Special Session at 8:16 p.m.
