**Ordinance 12-O-01, An Ordinance of the Mayor and Council of the City of College Park to Amend the Fiscal Year 2012 Operating and Capital Budget of the City of College Park, Maryland**

Mayor Fellows opened the Public Hearing on Ordinance 12-O-01 at 7:50 p.m. Finance Director Steve Groh gave an overview. There are two projects in the current CIP, the business assistance fund and the homeownership grant, that have expended all of their funds for FY 12. Both have grant requests pending. The business assistance program provides grants up to \$2,500 for signs, and the homeownership grant provides grants of \$5,000 for properties that are former rentals, foreclosures or short sales. This amendment provides additional funding to these programs to get us through the end of the fiscal year. He discussed the advertisement of this public hearing.
