

WEEKLY SUMMARY OF NON-ROUTINE ACTIVITY CITY OF COLLEGE PARK CONTRACT POLICE SERVICE

March 11-March 17, 2016

- 3/11** Contract officer observed an individual urinating in public in the 4300 block of Knox Road and issued a criminal citation.
- 3/11** Contract officer on routine patrol observed a junked vehicle parked on private property at 5000 block Lakeland Road. The officer submitted a Condition Report.
- 3/11** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at Calvert Road and Princeton Ave. 6 citations were issued.
- 3/11** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at Knoxville Drive at Edmonston Road. 9 citations were issued including a school bus.
- 3/12** Contract officer conducted a traffic stop for a speeding violation at Baltimore Ave and Knox Road. Investigation revealed the driver was impaired. The driver was arrested and charged with DUI. Note: 2nd offense for driver
- 3/12** Contract officers responded to a call for service for a Breaking and Entering in progress at 5000 block Fox Street. Contract officer arrived on the scene first and determined the suspect used forced entry but was GOA. Officer assisted with the perimeter as the investigation was turned over to an investigator.
- 3/14** Contract officer on routine patrol observed a suspicious vehicle driving slowly through Old Town neighborhood and conducted a traffic stop in the 6900 block of Dartmouth Ave. The officer conducted a field interview and discovered the occupant was from the Clinton area. No criminal violations were observed and the individual was sent on his way.
- 3/15** Contract officer conducted a traffic stop for a speeding violation at Baltimore Ave and Paint Branch Parkway. The officer issued a criminal citation for possession of an open alcoholic beverage.
- 3/16** Contract officer on routine patrol observed a suspicious vehicle (occupied twice) at De Pauw Place at Gettysburg Lane. Field interview was conducted and the officer determined that the occupants just finished smoking marijuana. No CDS was located and they were advised to leave the area.

Old Town Activity:

Contract officers responded to a few calls for service for loud parties in the Old Town neighborhood. Officers assigned to the Down Town Area as foot officers issued 10 warning citations for failure to obey upraised hand signal in the Down Town area (Baltimore Ave corridor)
