- 4/1 Contract officers responded to a call for service for a hold up alarm at the Seven Eleven Store located at 7201 Baltimore Ave. Contract officer was the first unit on the scene and determined the alarm accidentally activated.
- 4/1 Contract officers responded to a call for service for a loud party at 4300 block Knox Road. The occupants refused to open the door for the officer. Contract officer was able to determine that the occupants were students and 2 student referrals were completed. **Update: Based on the referrals both students met with the contract officer for a formal apology to include a written letter. Both students have enrolled in a 2 weeks ethics class as they were very remorseful for their actions.**
