

WEEKLY SUMMARY OF NON-ROUTINE ACTIVITY CITY OF COLLEGE PARK CONTRACT POLICE SERVICE

April 22-April 28, 2016

- 4/23** Contract officers assisted UMPD with a vehicle pursuit that ended after the suspect's vehicle collided with a utility pole at Baltimore Ave and Guilford Drive. The suspects bailed out of the vehicle and made good on their escape.
- 4/23** Contract officer issued a criminal citation for possession of an open alcoholic beverage at College Ave and Rhode Island Ave. UMPD was on the scene and will complete a student referral.
- 4/24** Contract officer assisted the beat officers with the report of a strong arm robbery at 8310 Baltimore Ave (McDonalds). Officer conducted a canvass with negative results.
- 4/25** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at Knoxville Drive at Edmonston Road. 2 citations and 2 warnings were issued.
- 4/25** Contract officer conducted a traffic stop in the 8400 block of Baltimore Ave. The driver was wanted on an outstanding warrant and charged with possession of CDS (33 grams of marijuana and 18 xanax pills). He was placed under arrest without incident and transported to DOC for processing.
- 4/26** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at Apache Road and Rhode Island Ave. 17 warnings were issued
- 4/26** Contract officers responded to a call for service for a disorderly person at the Applebee's located at Hartwick Road and Baltimore Ave. The suspect assaulted the victim inside the restaurant and was involved in another altercation at the intersection of Hartwick Road and Baltimore Ave. During the field interview the suspect assaulted the contract officer and displayed aggressive behavior. Officers used a taser and OC spray to control the suspect. The suspect was arrested and transported to PGGH for treatment. The suspect was under the influence of marijuana, cocaine, Prozac and alcohol.
- 4/27** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Crosswalk Enforcement) at Hollywood Road and Rhode Island Ave. 3 warning citations were issued.
- 4/27** Contract officer responded to a call for service for a suspicious person threatening people in which he claimed to be armed with a gun. Officers located the suspect and discovered he was wanted on 3 outstanding warrants. Suspect was transported to DOC for processing.
- 4/28** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at 52nd Ave at Iroquois Street. 1 citation and 5 warnings were issued.
