

WEEKLY SUMMARY OF NON-ROUTINE ACTIVITY CITY OF COLLEGE PARK CONTRACT POLICE SERVICE

April 29-May 5, 2016

- 4/29** Contract officer stopped a vehicle for failure to yield the right of way to a pedestrian in the crosswalk at Baltimore Ave at Knox Road. During the officer's investigation, the driver was placed under arrest for DUI and 10 grams of marijuana was seized from the vehicle. 5 citations in lieu of arrest were issued for possession of an open alcoholic beverage and 2 civil citations were issued for possession of marijuana to the occupants of the vehicle. The driver was transported to DOC for processing.
- 5/2** Contract officers responded to a call for service for a hold up alarm at the Seven Eleven Store located at 8600 Baltimore Ave. The alarm was accidentally activated by the employee.
- 5/2** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Crosswalk Enforcement) in the 7200 block of Rhode Island Ave. No violations noted
- 5/3** Contract officer conducted a traffic stop at MD Rt. 193 at Metzert Road. The driver gave the officer false information and was also wanted on 2 outstanding warrants. The suspect was transported to DOC and charged accordingly.
- 5/3** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at Knoxville Drive at Edmonston Road. 2 citations and 1 warning were issued.
- 5/3** Contract officer conducted a traffic stop at Paint Branch Parkway and River Road. The driver was placed under arrest for suspended license as he received a prior citation for the same offense on 4/28/16. The driver was transported to DOC and charged accordingly.
- 5/4** Contract officers responded to a call for service for a panic/medical alarm at 9300 block Limestone Place. The alarm was accidentally activated by the homeowner.
- 5/4** Contract officer responded to a call for service for a trespasser at the Seven Eleven Store located at 8150 Baltimore Ave. The suspect was placed under arrest and transported to DOC and charged accordingly.
- 5/4** Contract officer responded to a call for service to assist investigators that spotted an individual wanted on a breaking and entering charge at Dartmouth Road at Calvert Road. The suspect fled on foot but was apprehended in a nearby backyard. The suspect was transported to DOC for processing.
- 5/5** Contract officer responded to a call for service for a report of a citizen strong arm robbery at 4700 block Calvert Road in which a bicycle was taken. The Contract Officer located

the suspect at Baltimore Ave at Calvert Road and made apprehension. The suspect was turned over to investigators for processing.

During the investigation a total of 4 persons were arrested and turned over to investigators from the WAVE Team. The vehicle was located and was originally stolen from Tennessee.
