

WEEKLY SUMMARY OF NON-ROUTINE ACTIVITY CITY OF COLLEGE PARK CONTRACT POLICE SERVICE

May 6-May 12, 2016

- 5/6** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at Knoxville Drive at Edmonston Road. Officer issued 3 citations for excessive speed and 8 citations for failure to stop at the stop sign.
- 5/6** Contract officers conducted high visibility at shopping centers within the city due to the homicide incident that occurred in Montgomery County.
- 5/7** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at Hollywood Road and 47th Ave. 3 citations and 1 warning were issued
- 5/7** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at Berwyn Road and 49th Ave. 2 citations and 2 warnings were issued
- 5/9** Contract officer observed a suspicious person in the 9000 block of Saint Andrews Place and conducted a field interview. The individual was released without charges as the incident was documented on a Field Observation Report.
- 5/10** Contract officer (Off Duty) observed a male suspect attempting to enter several vehicles in the Hollywood Area. Additional contract officers responded to the area and after a brief foot chase the suspect was apprehended at the Seven Eleven Store on Edgewood Road. The suspect confessed to attempting to break into 27 vehicles in the College Park area. The suspect was charged with one count of attempted theft but the remaining charges will be screened by the S/A Office for additional charges. Note: This individual was arrested by the contract officers several weeks ago for the same offense.
- 5/10** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Speed Enforcement) at Greenbelt Road and Rhode Island Ave. 9 warnings were issued
- 5/10** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Speed Enforcement) at Paint Branch Parkway and River Road. 12 warnings were issued
- 5/11** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at 51st Ave and Edgewood Road. 4 warnings were issued
- 5/11** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Crosswalk Enforcement) on the Rhode Island Ave corridor with no violations occurring.
