

WEEKLY SUMMARY OF NON-ROUTINE ACTIVITY CITY OF COLLEGE PARK CONTRACT POLICE SERVICE

June 3-June 9, 2016

- 6/3** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at 48th Ave at Navahoe Street. 1 warning was issued
- 6/3** Contract officer on routine patrol observed a panhandler at Baltimore Ave at Edgewood Road. The officer warned this individual on several occasions and was issued a state citation for panhandling.
- 6/3** Contract officer responded to a call for service for a report of the sound of gunshots in the area of 51st Ave at Huron Street. While on the scene the officers heard additional gun shots. Officers recovered 2 shell castings and a search for the suspects turned up negative.
- 6/4** Contract officer responded to a call for service for a report of a theft at the Target located at 7501 Baltimore Ave. Contract officer arrived on the scene first and discovered that the suspect jumped over the pharmacy counter and stole several containers of prescription medication. A search of the area revealed negative results. Investigation is ongoing.
- 6/7** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at 48th Ave at Navahoe Street. 1 citation and 2 warnings were issued
- 6/8** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment (Stop Sign Enforcement) at 48th Ave at Navahoe Street. 2 warnings were issued
- 6/8** Contract officer was on routine patrol in the area of 4600 block College Ave when he heard a loud bang. The officer observed the 2 suspects running from the rear of the residence. Shortly thereafter the suspects started to vandalize the house by toilet papering it. Additional officers were requested and the suspects were detained. Investigation revealed the suspects threw a rock through the basement door window. The suspects were involved in a prior incident with another person at a local bar and decided to vandalize his home in revenge. The suspects damaged the wrong house as the other individual didn't live at this address. 5 criminal citations were issued and UMPD officers responded to the scene to assist. 2 student referrals were completed on both suspects as they were students at the university.
- 6/9** Contract officer conducted a traffic assignment on Berwyn Road. The following citations were issued: 2 excessive speed, 3 seatbelt, 7 stop sign, and 3 unregistered vehicles.
