

Curbside Donation Event – May 30th, 2014



WHO: Residents of **Berwyn, Lakeland, Old Town, Calvert Hills, and Crystal Springs**

(Berwyn/Lakeland include homes between Greenbelt Rd and Paint Branch

Pkwy, and east of Rt. 1. Old Town/Calvert Hills includes single family homes between Albion and Norwich, and east of Rt. 1 to Columbia. Crystal Springs includes homes south of Metzert Rd., including Acredale Ct. and Patricia Ct.)

WHEN: Friday May 30th - set items out by 10:00 am!

WHERE: Curbside at your address – *the donation truck will come to you!*

WHAT to donate: Anything reusable in good condition!

**Appliances (functioning) • Art supplies • Books • CDs, DVDs • Clothes
Kitchen items (dishes, utensils, etc.) • Linens, blankets, curtains, towels
Closet organizers & shelving • Furniture (intact pieces only!) • Games
School supplies (backpacks, etc.) • Sporting equipment**

NO CRT TVs, mattresses, couches, or other upholstered furniture please!



★ **Unopened/unused cleaning supplies, toiletries, and non-perishable food will be collected separately for donation to a local shelter.**



HOW to donate:

1. Call or email Loree (**240-487-3593; lohagan@collegeparkmd.gov**) with your address and the items you wish to donate. **Please schedule at least a day in advance!**
2. Bag your donations, mark them “for donation” and set at the curb by 10:00 am – keep separated from trash items.
3. Keep unopened cleaning supplies, toiletry items and non-perishable food separate.

Important! – The donation truck driver has final discretion on whether to accept the items you have set out.
Proper disposal or alternate donation of items not accepted by ARW will be your responsibility.

WHY donate: Why not? Donating reusable items you no longer want or need is a great way to help others in our local community and to conserve landfill space and natural resources.
