### Engineering

- NZI Construction has begun repairing sidewalks, curbs, and driveway aprons in Old Town in advance of WSSC's pavement resurfacing. WSSC is tentatively scheduled to begin their resurfacing activities of the affected streets in early July.
- 

### Planning

- The Director participated in a bid review with the apparent low bidder on the Duvall Field project. The consulting engineer and Finance Director were also in attendance.
  - The Director attended a DCPMA meeting where Joseph Verde from Bookholders was elected President and planning for a new fall event for freshmen students was discussed.
  - The Director participated in a conference call with CPCUP and the City Attorney to discuss streamlining dual use of our Homeownership programs.
  - The Director and Senior Planner met with the City Clerk and Assistant Public Works Director to review the draft report on the Parish House. Some revisions and additional information are required before the report will be made final.
  - The Senior Planner and the Old Town Local Advisory Committee conducted a field visit and meeting regarding Historic Area Work Permit issues at 4619 College Avenue.
  - The Senior Planner met with representatives from Enterprise Leasing in College Park who are exploring a possible redevelopment of their property at Baltimore Avenue and Fox Street.
  - The Community Development Coordinator and Director continued coordination with Zagster and University View on the planned station installation there. The Director also met with the Mayor of University Park to discuss extending mBike to two locations in University Park.

### Public Works

- Move-outs still continue; therefore, on Saturday, May 28, DPW had a two person crew collecting move-out debris from the City.
- Monday's Memorial Day Ceremony went very well. DPW crew set-up the site in the morning and then had the area torn down and street reopened by 12:30 pm.
- The Maryland Department of Agriculture (MDA) begins mosquito larvicide control of standing water that are known breeding areas to help reduce adult populations. MDA will conduct adult mosquito survey counts to determine if spray threshold levels are met, prior to spraying to control adult mosquitoes.

- The Mosquito Spray Control Program will resume **June 1st, 2016** and continue through the fall. Mosquito spraying occurs on Wednesday nights in College Park, if the spray criteria are met.
