



DPW is preparing for the forecast snow event on Friday January 22nd. City streets were treated on Wednesday night with a salt brine solution to prevent snow from sticking to the streets. DPW salt trucks have been making supplemental treatments on streets to further eliminate icing on inclines and intersections on Thursday. Plow trucks are equipped and ready to begin snow operations when precipitation begins. DPW crews have been assigned to snow removal routes in two, twelve hour shifts to cover the extended event. The snow control center will be staffed to answer calls and monitor snow removal operations.
