

**ORDINANCE**  
**OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE PARK, MARYLAND,**  
**AMENDING CHAPTER 11, “AUTHORITIES”, ARTICLE 1 “HOUSING AUTHORITY”**  
**TO DELETE AN UNNECESSARY PROVISION.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Art. 23A, §2, the City of College Park, Maryland (hereinafter, the “City”) has the power to pass such ordinances as it deems necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 12-101 *et seq.* of the Housing and Economic Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland enables the establishment of housing authority in Municipalities for certain purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council adopted Chapter 11 “Authorities” Article I “Housing Authority” pursuant to Section 12-101 *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council have determined that §11-4 “HUD Existing-Housing Assistance Payments Program” is no longer required.

**Section 1.** **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED**, by the Mayor and Council of the City of College Park, Maryland that Chapter 11 “Authorities” Article I, “Housing Authority”, §11-3 “HUD Existing Housing Assistance Payments Program” be, and is hereby, repealed:

~~[Pursuant to the Housing Authorities Law and pursuant to the approval heretofore given for the same by the Housing Authority of the City of College Park, the College Park Planning and Community Development Director [Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program] authorized under the Housing and Community Development Act is hereby constituted and empowered as the agency for the development and administration of the HUD Section 8 Existing Housing Assistance Payments Program within the City of College Park.]~~

**Section 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of College Park that, upon formal introduction of this proposed Ordinance, which shall be by way of a motion duly seconded and without any further vote, the City Clerk shall distribute a copy to each Council member and shall maintain a reasonable number of copies in the office of the City Clerk and shall publish this proposed ordinance or a fair summary thereof in a newspaper having a general circulation in the City of College Park together with a notice setting out the time and place for a public hearing thereon and for its consideration by the Council. The public hearing, hereby set for \_\_\_\_\_ P.M. on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2010, shall follow the publication by at least seven (7) days, may be held separately or in connection with a regular or special Council meeting and may be adjourned from time to time. All persons interested shall have an opportunity to be heard. After the hearing, the Council may adopt the proposed ordinance with or without amendments or reject it. As soon as practicable after adoption, the City Clerk shall have a fair summary of the Ordinance and notice of its adoption published in a newspaper having a general circulation in the City of College Park and available at the City's offices. This Ordinance shall become effective on \_\_\_\_\_, 2010 provided that a fair summary of this Ordinance is published at least once prior to the date of passage and once as soon as practical after the date of passage in a newspaper having general circulation in the City.
