1. **How Martin Luther King Jr. Changed Society?**
2. **How Martin Luther King Jr's Influence Shaped American People**
3. **Use one of the following quotes to write about how Martin Luther King Jr. lived/showed this in his life.**
  - a. Everyone has the power for greatness, not for fame, but greatness, because greatness is determined by service.”
