Individuals interested in serving on the Recreation Board should have interest and expertise in entertainment, recreation, sports, social activities, organizational skills, media relations, and consensus building.

B. Proposed Mission:

The City Events Advisory Board recommends, advises, and assists City staff on budgeted events and recreational activities that meet the interests of the City's diverse community of residents and additionally, attract visitors to the City. Individuals interested in serving on the City Events Advisory Board should have interest and expertise in entertainment, recreation, social activities, community goals and needs, and community-building.

Jane Hopkins motioned to accept the new mission statement. Santosh Chelliah seconded the motion. All were in favor. None were opposed. The motion passed.

The name change will take effect after formal vote and approval from the Mayor and City Council.
