









Definitions:

Robbery: The taking or attempting to take anything of value under confrontation circumstances from the control, custody, or care of another by force or threat of force and/or by putting the victim in fear of immediate harm.

Burglary: the unlawful entry into a building or other structure with the intent to commit a felony or theft.

Quality of Life: Calls for Service that include Disorderly, Loitering, CDS Complaints.
