

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE PARK  
TO DISCHARGE THE CANDIDATES' DEBATE WORKGROUP**

**WHEREAS**, on September 27, 2016, the City Council adopted Resolution 16-R-25 to establish the Candidates' Debate Workgroup ("Workgroup") to develop recommendations to present to the Mayor and Council outlining the City's and the Supervisors of Elections role, if any, in candidates' debates for municipal elections; and

**WHEREAS**, the Workgroup presented their report to the City Council on June 6, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted Resolution 17-R-10 on June 13, 2017 adopting Rules and Procedures for Candidates' Events based on those recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council asked the Workgroup to provide additional recommendations related to referendum questions placed on the ballot; and

**WHEREAS**, the Workgroup provided the additional guidelines in an Information Report to Council on August 2, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the Candidates' Debate Workgroup has now completed their charge.




