Green Awards

A Program to Recognize College Park's Environmental Leaders



Each year, the City of College Park Committee for a Better Environment (CBE) recognizes nominations for special effort made by members of the local community to protect and conserve the environment.

In addition to commending those who have contributed in some way to a healthier environment, CBE hopes to:

- Increase environmental awareness.
- Encourage wider appreciation of nature and adoption of environmentally responsible practices.

Who's Eligible?

Residents of College Park, as well as businesses, organizations, associations, and institutions that operate or are located in the City of College Park.¹

Here are just a few examples of potential Green Award candidates:

- ✓ A business that minimizes the use of non-recyclable materials or packaging.
- ✓ A gardener who limits the use of water, chemicals, or power equipment when creating and/or maintaining his or her garden.
- ✓ A neighbor who regularly cleans up litter in the community.

- ✓ A club or youth group that reuses and repurposes materials for projects.
- ✓ A group or individual who promotes or educates others in environmentally sustainable activities.
- ✓ A person or group that builds or remodels using highly efficient, energy and water saving green methods.
- ✓ Someone who installs a bee house/hotel in their yard.
- ✓ A property owner who focuses on planting and maintaining native, pollinator-friendly plants, creating welcoming habitat for bees, butterflies, hummingbirds, and other pollinators, or actively creates wild pollinator-friendly habitat, such as hedgerows and wild spaces.
- ✓ A community advocate who engages in educating others on pollinators and their protection.
- ✓ A property owner who changes the management of their property (e.g., no spray, integrated pest management approaches, etc.) to protect wild pollinators and pollinator friendly vegetation.



¹ * Members of the CBE, Bee City Committee or their immediate family members and workplaces are not eligible for an award.

The Winners

Up to four Green Awards are given each year. Award recipients will be notified by CBE as soon as possible after judging.

In addition to receiving a certificate of appreciation, winners receive a \$100 check from the City of College Park. Presentations will be made by the CBE and presented at a CBE meeting.
